Integrated Solutions for Food Security, Forest Protection, and Climate Resilience

Alphome Community Farms works with rural communities across the Democratic Republic of Congo to grow food sustainably, protect forests, and build resilient livelihoods for farmers, youth, and women. Our work is grounded in the belief that **people and nature must thrive together** — and that lasting climate impact starts with community leadership.

Our Integrated Approach

1. Climate-Smart Agriculture

We strengthen food systems by helping farmers increase productivity while restoring soils and ecosystems:

- Improved seeds and climate-resilient crop varieties
- Conservation agriculture and soil regeneration
- Farmer field schools and demonstration plots
- Agroforestry and tree integration on farms
- Youth and women farmer leadership programs

2. Community-Led Forest Protection

We empower communities to defend their forests using data, technology, and local action:

- Satellite forest monitoring with Global Forest Watch

- Forest Watcher community patrols and field verification
- Advocacy against mining and charcoal-driven deforestation
- Reporting and engagement with authorities and customary leaders
- Forest restoration and enrichment planting

3. Sustainable Livelihoods & Green Jobs

We reduce pressure on forests by creating viable economic alternatives:

- Agro-processing and value chain development

- Market access and cooperative strengthening
- Clean cooking and alternative energy solutions
- Digital tools for farmers and forest monitors
- Youth green entrepreneurship and skills training

Where We Work

We currently operate in high-impact landscapes including: - **Haut-Uele Province:** Watsa and Faradje Territories

- **South-Kivu Province:** Rural farming and forest communities
